Text: James 4:13-17

Synopsis: Think of the best day of your life. Maybe it's the day you got married or the birth of child. Maybe it's the first home you ever bought or the dream job that you worked all your life to get. Maybe it's the day your team went to the state championships or your graduation from college. Now think of the joy and enthusiasm that went along with that day.

What if everyday was like that? What if every moment we lived held the same kind of joy and enthusiasm? But they don't do they? If we are honest, most of our lives are lived in between moments. Too often those moments are far apart and in between is a lot of hurt and disappointment.

James teaches us that every moment with God is pregnant with joy and opportunity, even when those moments are difficult. God delights in doing good things for his children and he never tires of doing them. But we have to learn to live in his moment. When we learn how to live in God's moment we become like children playing with our earthly fathers saying, "Do it again dad!" Eventually every dad gets tired and says, "No you run along and go play," but God never does. He does good things over and over again but we have to learn to say, "Do it again God." And he always does.
